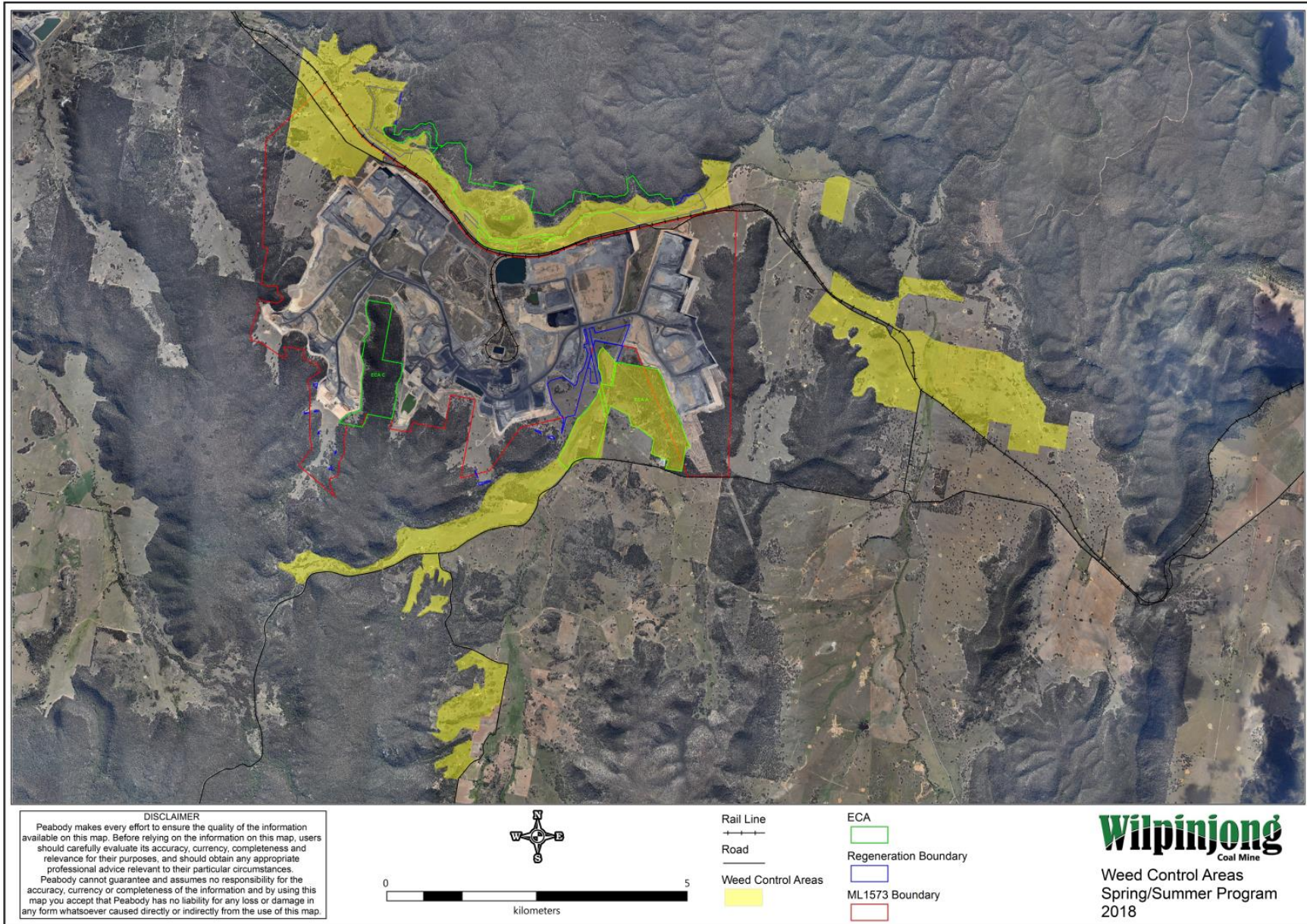

Please be advised that Wilpinjong Coal will be conducting an autumn dog/fox baiting program on Peabody owned land as per the attached map (bait trails shown as red line). The baiting program will **commence Saturday 21 April 2018**. The baiting program will continue for an approx. 6 week period with all baits collected and disposed of by **Sunday 27 May 2018**.

The baiting program is conducted in accordance with the requirements of the Pesticide Control Order (1080 Liquid Concentrate and Bait Products) 2010, Schedule 1 (Control of Wild Dogs) and Schedule 2 (Control of Foxes). This includes;

- notification of the program – provided by this Letter and notification at Wollar Store
- signage – will be erected as required prior to baits being laid
- bait collection and disposal – will occur by **Sunday 27 May 2018**

The baiting program is timed to coincide with the Munghorn Wild Dog Group annual autumn baiting program to increase the coverage area and improve the effectiveness of the program for all local landholders. The bait trails have also been selected to address concerns about fox numbers within Wollar Village.

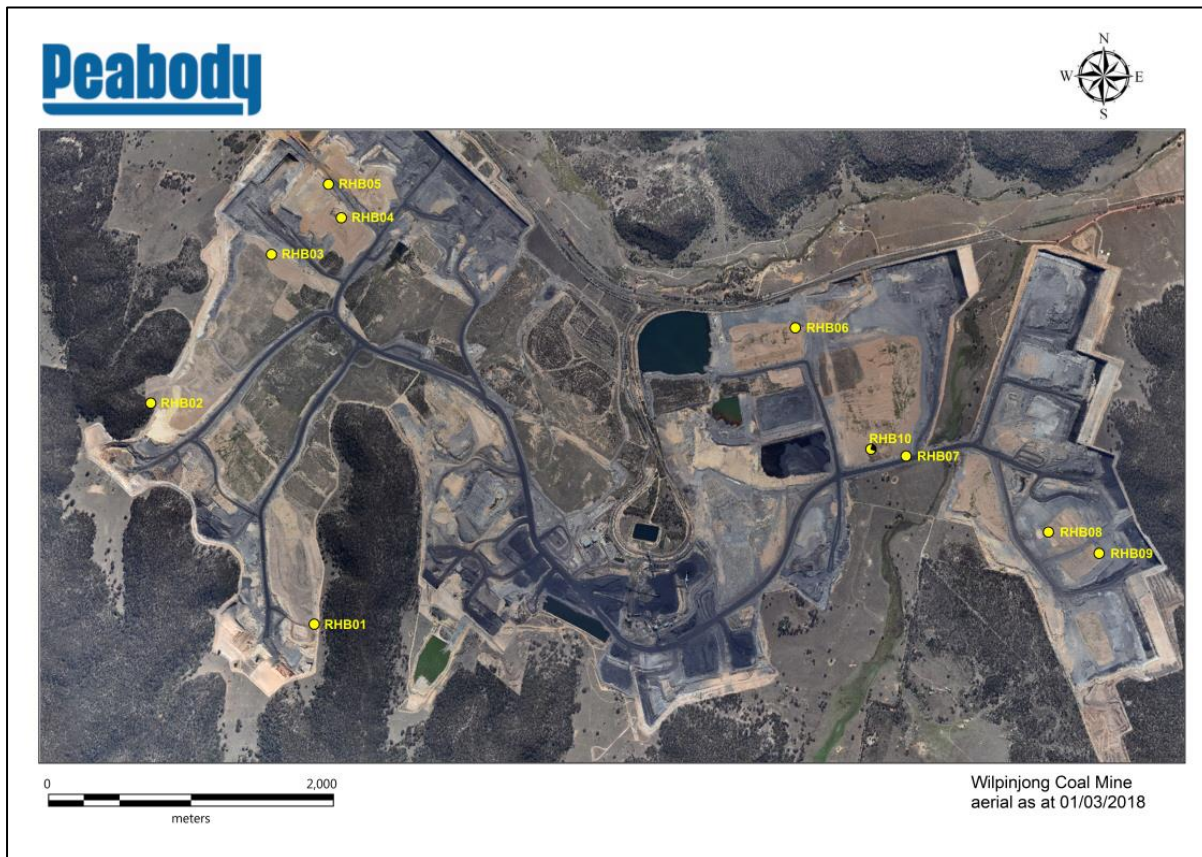
